The Nature Connection To Offer Free Workshop: *The Power Of Nature: A Family Caregiver Training* Connecting Loved Ones with Memory Loss Through Nature's Healing Power

WHAT:	On May 2, 2017, The Nature Connection – a Concord-based non-profit – will offer a free training session for family members seeking new ways to connect with aging/memory-impaired loved ones. Nature Connection staff will share best practices for incorporating nature activities into the caregiving role to enrich elders' lives and increase family connections. Learn new therapeutic techniques and gain hands-on experience utilizing a wide range of sensory and natural materials. The Town of Lexington and Cooperative Elder Services, Inc. are supporting partners.
	Training will consist of an introduction to The Nature Connection's programming and an overview of our methodology. Caregivers will learn to design new sensory and nature-based activities to conduct with loved ones, and gain practical experience leading each activity. Workshop will include role-playing and review of safe practices when utilizing live plant and natural materials. Gain tips on sourcing, preparing and utilizing a wide range of sensory materials, and learn successful practices for safe, yet challenging engagement. Refreshments served.
